ENERGY ASSISTANCE 2024-2025 HEATING SEASON

This Office of Social Service energy assistance season is now in progress for Northford and North Branford residents.

It is preferred that those that heat with a deliverable fuel such as oil, propane, or pellets are seen initially followed by utility heating customers. Utility heating customers should participate in a program offered by the utility company; there are several programs to choose from. The programs offered are medical protection, matching program, balance forgiveness and the like.

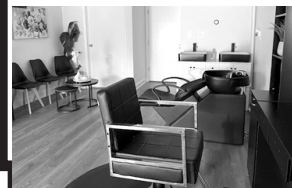
